## JON "BWANA" ARENSEN



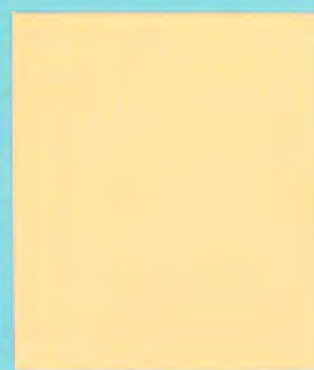




Throughout the past 18 years, Dr. A has touched numerous lives both at Houghton College and abroad in Tanzania through the Intercultural Studies department. Affectionately known as "Bwana," Dr. A and his wife "Mama" Barb have inspired and blessed many through the personal connection they strive to have with students.

Many speak of how their time in Tanzania was one that marked a change in direction for the rest of their lives. Bwana's unique teaching style and soul-stirring story-telling allows the information on a page to become concrete experiences that solidify learning for his students. Houghton History:

"In 1825, the Seneca Native Americans of the Houghton area sold their land to settlers, including one with a family by the name of Houghton. A Seneca named Copperhead claimed he had not received proper payment for the land. He believed the settlers of the area owed him a living, which he was given. He died at the age of 120 from burns he sustained after his cabin burned down and was buried next to his cabin at the intersection of Centerville and Old River Road. After heavy rains, the creek next to his house threatened to wash his remains down the hill. IN 1914, after reading an article in the Star about the matter, the students and friends raised money to move Copperhead's remains and establish a monument for him. He is currently buried under the large boulder near the map as you drive up the hill to campus. Years later, students had a contest to name the yearbook. Keith Farner, class of 1925, suggested the Boulder."

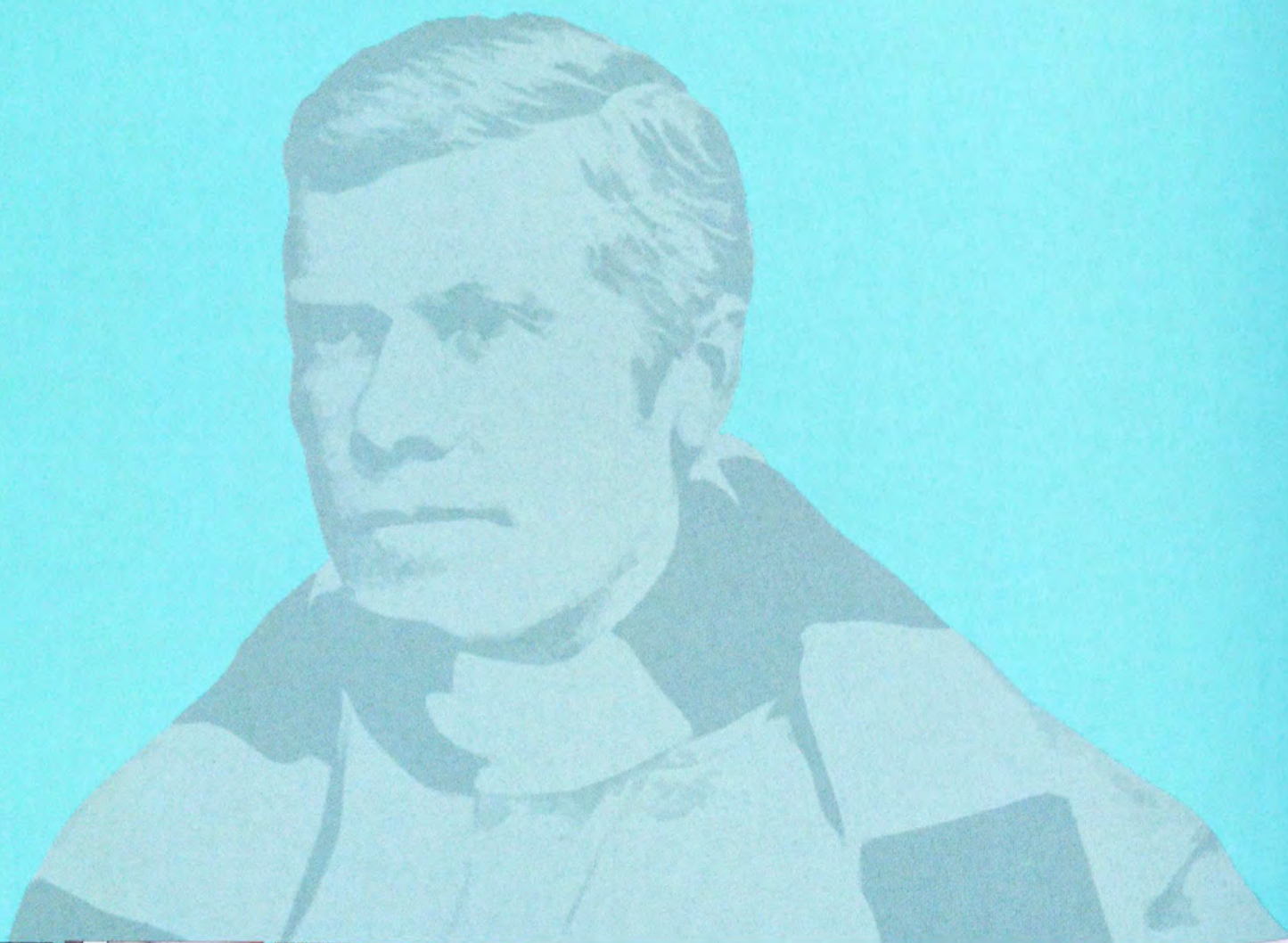
