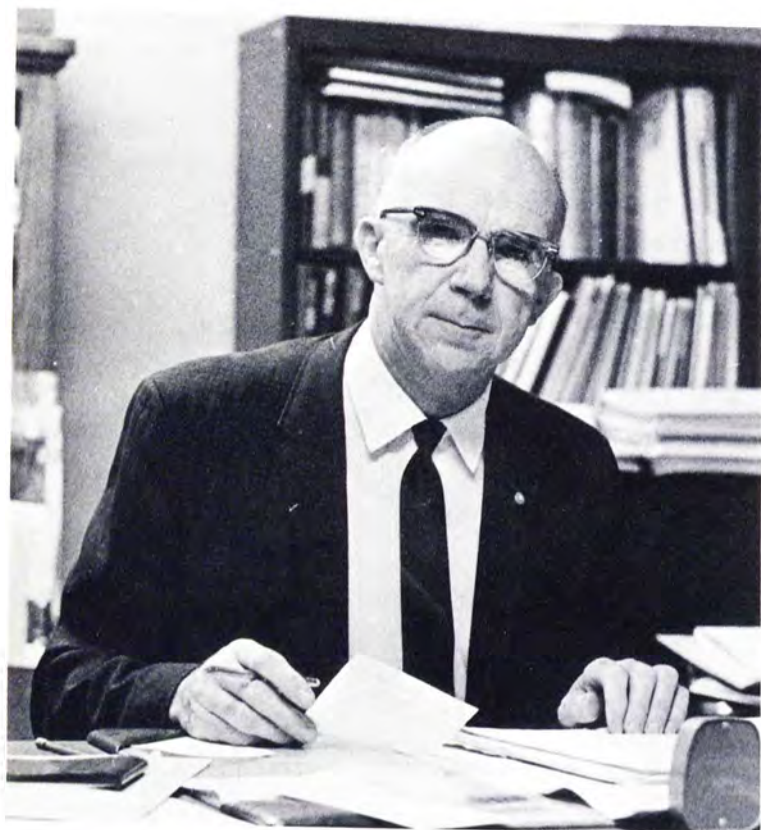
Dean of Women
