About the Music

Sailor's Odyssey arranged by David Bobrowitz explores the familiar sea chantey Drunken Sailor. The free-wheeling nature of the tune comes through, as young bands perform a nice array of articulations and thematic variations.

Suite from Bohemia is in four movements, written specifically for younger bands by Vaclav Nelhybel, evoking a sense of the medieval through programmatic titles and homophonic writing.

And the Nightwatchers Awake refers to the image and legend of gargoyles, the grotesque creatures found high above on cathedrals and other buildings to divert water and supposedly ward off evil spirits. The Letchworth Junior High Band students requested a piece sounding "haunted," "creepy," and "mysterious," and this inspired the character of the work. Evoking gargoyles coming to life, the piece expresses an eerie stillness, strength, ferocity, and even majestic power. This work was commissioned by Jason Decker and the Letchworth Junior High Band with a grant from the Arts Council for Wyoming County.

With music of luminous vocal resonance, percussive intensity, and shimmering instrumentation, internationally-performed composer *Carrie Magin* traverses a wide emotional range with her fresh and universal voice. She is currently Assistant Professor of Composition and Theory at Houghton College.

Iditarod is a work for wind ensemble by senior composition student *Hunter Gregory*.

Double Percussion Concerto is a two-movement work for two percussion soloists and wind ensemble. Presented in two movements, the work explores structural and stylistic complementation and how contrary elements are interdependent and symbiotic.

Amor de mi Alma is set to a stunning 16th century love poem, which translates "You are the Love of my Soul." A deeply emotive composition, the work contains a rich harmonic language and lucid vocal passages that are both expressive and masterfully written.
