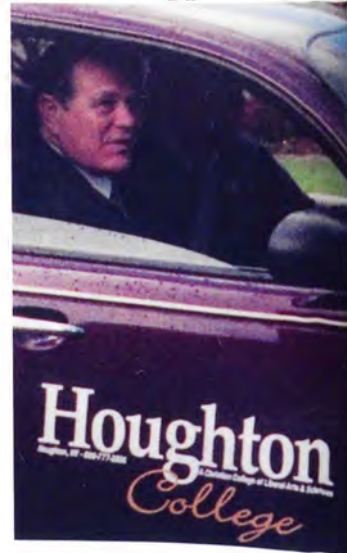


Dr. Chamberlain leads the way in the Houghton PT Cruiser

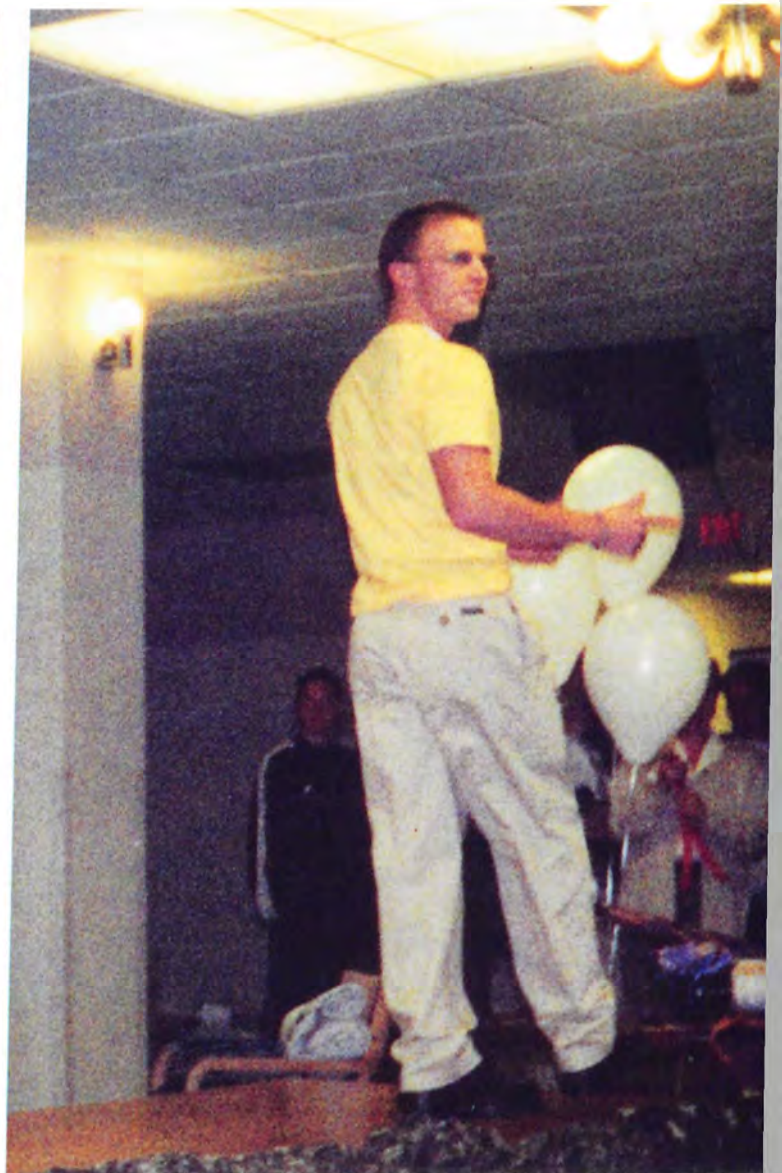

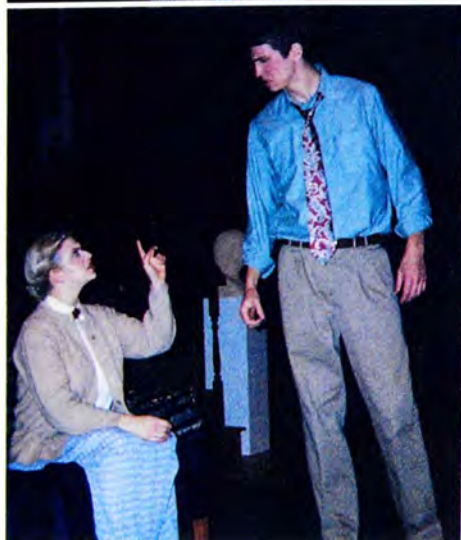
