

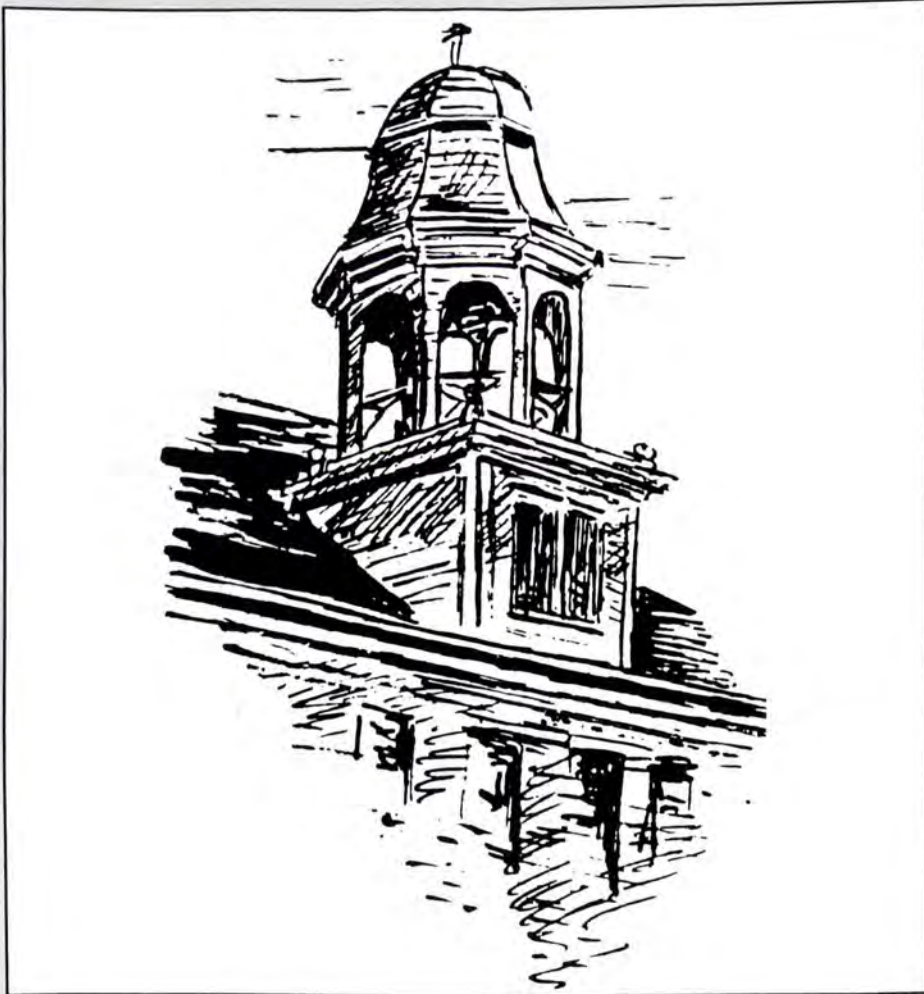

Dedicated to Cathy Daggett

In honor of her many years of service to Houghton College, we are dedicating the 2003 Boulder to Cathy Daggett. From 1992 until her retirement in 2003, Cathy was a professor at the Equestrian Center. Cathy grew up riding horses on her parents' farm, the historical Belvidere Estates near Belmont, NY. She and her father were members of the Genessee Valley Hunt Club where, at 16, Cathy became distinguished as the youngest member of the Hunt ever to earn her colors. Cathy went on to attend Alfred University where she graduated with a degree in Fine Arts and Design. She was the first person at the University to earn gym credit for Horsemanship.

Since coming to Houghton College, Cathy has volunteered her time for a salary of \$1 per year (which she never bothered to collect!). Cathy not only contributed her time and expertise to the college, but also lent her horses to the school for students to ride and train. She was instrumental in bringing the Equestrian Center into contact with people such as Sue and Terry Williams and Jack and Mark Frohm, who have donated top horses to the college. Cathy has also donated her own money to the improvement of the facilities themselves, including the arena barn, the office, two tack rooms, the barn truck, a tractor, and, most recently, an eight-stall addition to bi-level barn. It was Cathy's idea to start the Abdullah Trophy Award scholarship for outstanding students in the equestrian program.



Cathy has not only given her service to Houghton College, but is active in improving her community as well. She helped found and teach art at "Futures," a program in Bradford, PA designed to help mentally handicapped people learn valid job skills. She was also the District Commissioner for the area's Pony Club. Cathy is especially known for her dedication and service to St. Andrews Episcopal Church in Friendship, where she has been involved for most of her life.

But, Cathy's biggest contribution, by far, has been her love and dedication to the Houghton College students. Cathy spent many hours with students outside of class, helping them overcome difficult problems in their riding, and sharing with them her wealth of wisdom and knowledge, given in the language of stories from real-life experience mingled with her own brand of classic, down-to-earth humor. Cathy was dedicated to helping her students grow not only into better horsemen, but into mature scholar-servants with active spiritual lives. Those who were guided under Cathy's teaching will miss her greatly as she retires.

Thank you, Cathy, for all your time and dedication, your hard work, and your prayers. You helped us jump the fences we never thought we could clear. You gave us confidence when we felt we would never be prepared for the show. You taught us what it means to be real horsemen and not just riders. And, most of all, you showed us, by your example, the true picture of a scholar-servant.

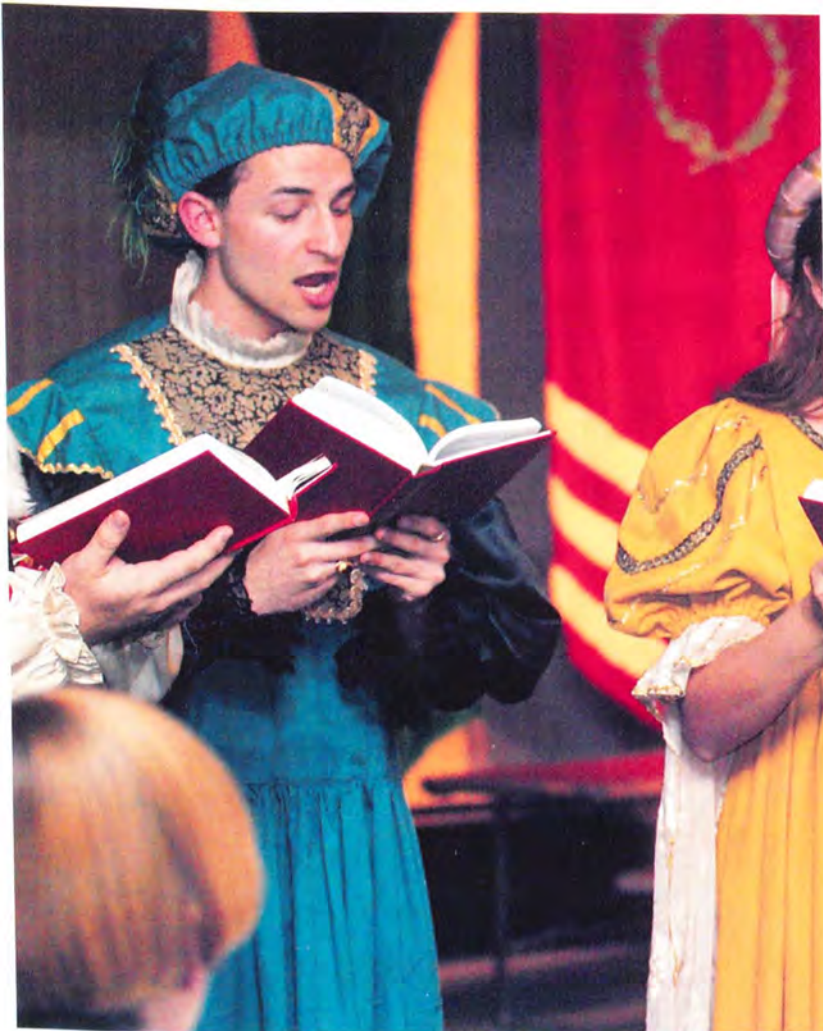

As a Professor...

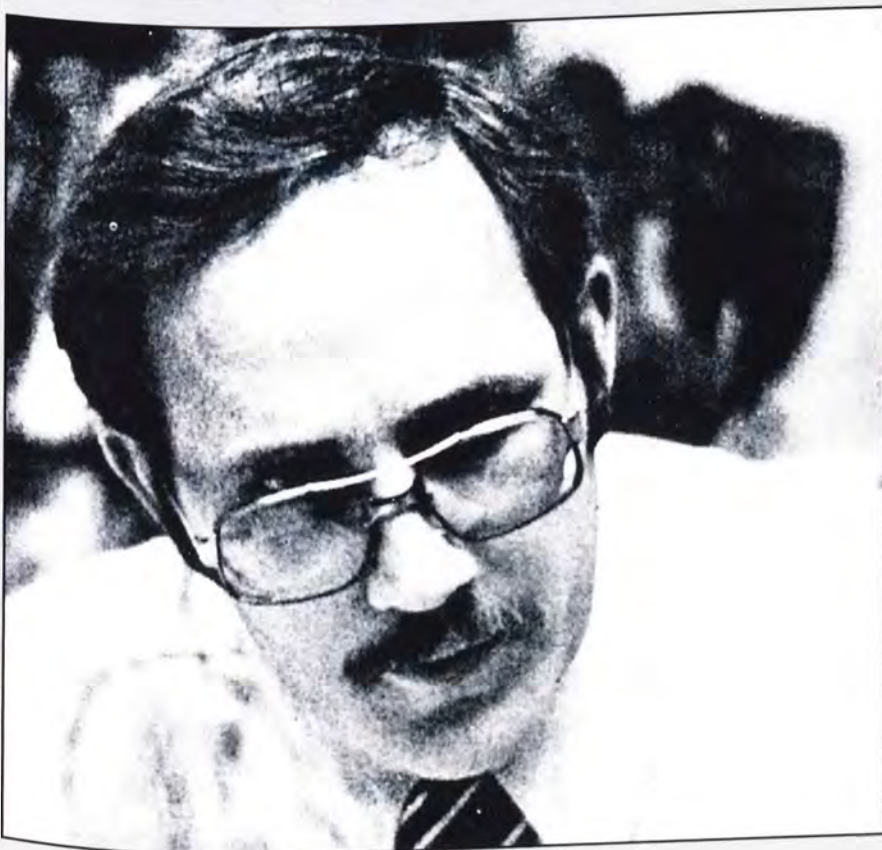

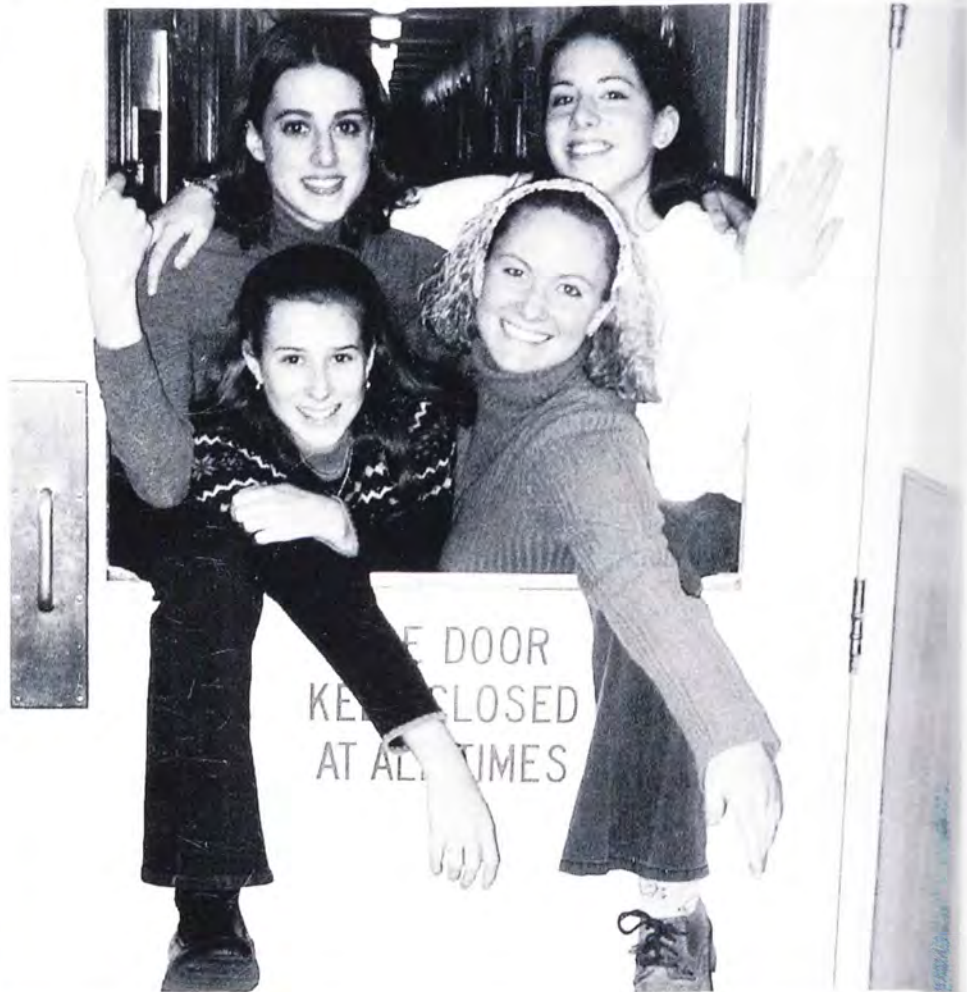
As a Community Member...

Fall 2002

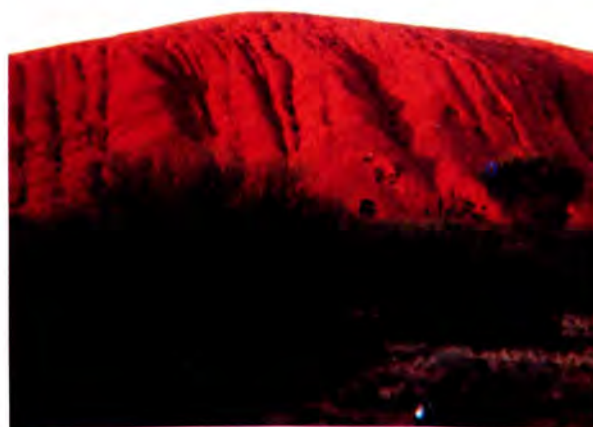
The inaugural "Houghton Down Under" program, in fall of 2003, proved to be a successful and lifechanging experience for the 21 students who participated. Our fifteen Houghton students, four Roberts Wesleyan students, and two Westmont students, led and guided by Dr. Michael and Nancy Walters, learned together, adventured together, and grew together. Through classes like Australian History, Australian Literature, and Postmodernity and Christianity, and through life in the city at Kingsley College in Melbourne, we were able to more fully grasp Australian Culture and how Christians relate to it. Through weekly group outings, as well as individual and small group adventures, we explored common cultural venues like Aussie rules football, hiking, camping, historical sites, and animal sanctuaries. The impact of our experiences in the context of a Christian community was huge--broadening our minds to see value and truth in a culture other than our own. It is safe to say we all fell in love with Australia and are thankful for the experiences and lasting effect. -Rebecca Mattoon



"Toto - I have a feeling we're not in Kansas anymore." Indeed, we were not! Putting 20 students in the avant-garde city of Melbourne and letting them find their way around was the recipe for breeding endless adventures that will be re-told and reminisced about for years to come.

How is one able to sum up an entire semester in just a few words? In reflecting back on my experiences there, I have realized how much I have gleaned from Australia, her people, and her culture. One lesson in particular has remained with me...

For some reason, when *they* hit the tennis ball, the ball connected with the racquet producing a resounding 'ping', and yet when *I* hit the ball, there was a lot of air and a big 'whomp.' Laughter from both parties always ensued. I was the American girl who had never played tennis. They were the Tongan-Australians, who grew up playing tennis.



They were my coaches, and I, their comic relief. We both lived on the Kingsley College campus, I as a student, participating in the Houghton Down Under program, and Atu, my Tongan friend and co-coach, as a professor there. Throughout the four months, and with many lessons from Atu and his extended family, my 'whomps' slowly turned into 'pings', and I grew to love the sport and the people who taught it to me.

My friendship with the Tongans is an example of a greater lesson: the importance of relationships. For those who don't know me, you won't know that I have struggled with balancing time with friends and time for academics on the teeter-totter of Houghton life. The teeter-totter has mostly been planted firmly on the academic side, leaving me with good grades, but many relationships that hadn't deepened. Being in Australia, I wasn't going to let *any* opportunity pass my way if I had any say. I knew I was there to study and experience, that my time here at Houghton is meant for the same. Undeniably, I am here to learn, but I am also here to experience, to engage in meaningful relationships. Best of all: both are possible.

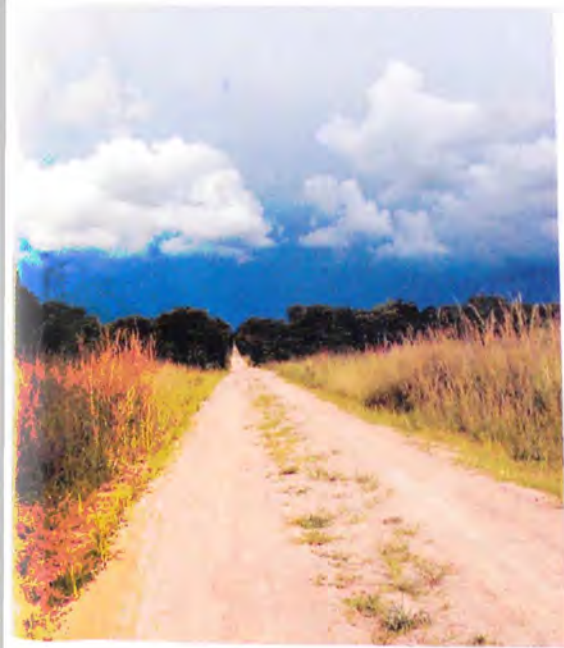
